Our *Liturgist* this morning is Deanna Hammond.


Today we welcome our *Guest Organist*, Dorothy Lorenz.

Today we will collect the *Peace and Global Witness offering*. This offering enables the church to promote the Peace of Christ by addressing systems of conflict and injustice across the world.


















YOU ARE INVITED TO JOIN US FOR OUR UPCOMING WORSHIP SERIES, "TELLING YOUR STORY"
